Captain Lori Luhnaw is the former Director of the San Diego Family Justice Center (SDFJC). The SDFJC is a 40,000 square foot facility that currently houses 16 partner agencies that provide onsite services to Domestic Violence Victims. Captain Luhnaw directed operations for the facility and also oversaw the Domestic Violence Unit for the San Diego Police Department. The San Diego Police Department's Domestic Violence Unit is responsible for handling approximately 8000 Domestic Violence case reports each year.

Captain Luhnaw has been a San Diego Police Officer for more than twenty years. Her past assignments include Patrol Lieutenant, Auto theft/ Night Investigative Team Supervisor, Juvenile Services Team Supervisor, Vice – ABC Licensing, Vice Operations, Recruiting/Backgrounds, Motorcycle Officer, DUI Enforcement Team Member, Accident Investigator, and Field Training Officer. She has worked in culturally diverse areas of the City of San Diego, and has managed hundreds of Domestic Violence calls and Investigations in her career. Captain Luhnaw has worked with the Mid-City Division's Domestic Violence Response Team and the Mid-City Multi Cultural Relations Office to create guidelines that enhanced on scene advocacy accessibility and reporting in the area of Domestic Violence. Captain Luhnaw has a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Communication, a Master's Degree in Organization Management, and her Advanced Police Officer's Standard and Training (POST) Certificate. She is also a graduate of the POST Supervisory Leadership Institute.
